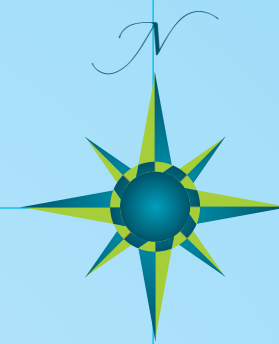

NORTH ROUTE

- SAN JUAN**
- Escambrón Beach Park
Bike, jog, roller blade and sea side bridge travel along the park's ocean front side walks. Route 25 at stop 8, San Juan. Tel. 787-449-567
 - Botanical Garden
Affiliated with the University of Puerto Rico. Collections of native and endangered plants in the island. Route 1, at Route 847. Open daily 9am-4:30pm Tel. 787-767-1710
- GUAYNABO**
- San Patricio Urban Forest
53 acres forest, contains 30 species of bird, 4 species of reptiles and 30 species of trees with interpretive walks. Route 23, Roosevelt Ave., at end of Ensenada street. Open Tue-Sun 9am-5pm Tel. 787-502-0159
- VEGA ALTA**
- Vega Forest
Wide caves, hiking trails, deep sinkholes and 12 types of soil. 72 trees species and 15 birds species. Route 676. Km 1.5 Open Tue-Sun 9am-5pm Tel. 787-883-2240
- VEGA BAJA**
- Tortuguero Lagoon Natural Reserve
Reserve formed by bodies of water, swamps, marshland and several mogotes. Home to exotic flowers and several endangered species. Route 686, Km.7.9 Open daily 7am-6pm Tel. 787-884-2587
- BARCELONETA**
- Cambalache Forest
Subtropical forest with impressive karst formations. Observe 6 endemic bird species. Route 682 km. 6.3 Open Tue-Sun 9am-5pm Tel. 787-881-1004
- ARECIBO**
- Radio Telescope
The world's largest with 1000-ft diameter spherical reflector, operated by Cornell University under cooperative agreement with the National Science Foundation. End of Route 625. Open Wed-Fri 12pm-4pm, Sat-Sun 9am-4pm Tel. 787-878-2612
- CAMUY**
- Camuy River Cave Park
Massive formations on a paved walkway to the bottom of a giant sinkhole. Route 129, Km 18.9. Open Wed-Sun 8:30am-3:30pm Tel. 787-898-3100

- WEST ROUTE - PORTA DEL SOL**
- ÍSABELA**
- Guajataca Forest
Extensive hiking trail system with observation tower, bird watching, camping and karst area. Route 446, south of Route 2. Tel. 787-872-1045
- MAYAGÜEZ**
- Dr. Juan A. Rivero Zoo
Take the kids to see the animals in an open, savanna-like environment. Route 108, just north of Route 65. Open Wed-Sun 8:30am-4:00pm (Tue-Sun in summer and holidays) Tel. 787-834-8110

- CENTRAL ROUTE**
- ADJUNTAS**
- Guilarte Forest
Hiking trails to Guilarte Peaks (3,950 feet) and visitor centers. 172 tree species. Route 518 and 131 Open Tue-Sun 9am-5pm Tel. 787-829-5767
- UTUADO**
- Dos Bocas Lake
Boats are available to take you around the lake to one of the many restaurants for lakeside dining. A great recreational area. Route 10, at Route 123. Open daily restaurants are open on weekends. Tel. 787-894-3505
 - Rio Abajo Forest
Located within karst and cave formations. Home to 175 plant and 34 bird species. Route 621. Open Tue-Sun 9am-5pm Tel. 787-880-6557
- JAYUYA**
- Toro Negro State Forest
Hike the tallest peaks of Puerto Rico: Cerro Punta & Cerro La Rosa. Great hiking with lots to see waterfalls, lake, river and more trees and birds species. Route 143, Km 32.4, east of Route 149. Open Tue-Sun 9am-5pm Tel. 787-867-3040
- OROCOVIS**
- Toro Negro Lookout Tower
Extraordinary view of the south coast. Route 143. Doña Juana Recreational Area Open Mon-Sun 9am-5pm. Tel. 787-867-5745

- CABO ROJO - COMBATE**
- Salt Flats and Lighthouse
Salt flats and piles of harvest salt. End of Route 301. Tel. 787-255-1560
- LAJAS - LA PARGUERA**
- Bioluminescent Bay
Must take a moonless night trip for little dinoflagellate watching. Boats leave from La Parguera dock. Trips from 7:30pm-1:00am. Tel. 787-899-1660
 - Parguera Natural Reserve
30 mangrove cays and islands form ornate channels. Off the coast of La Parguera, Route 304. Tel. 787-899-1660

- GUÁNICA**
- Guánica Dry Forest
A World Biosphere Reserve with cactus, 400-year-old Guayacán tree, bird-watching and beaches. Route 333 to 334. Open Tue-Sun 9:00am-5:00pm. Tel. 787-821-5706

- SABANA GRANDE**
- Susua Forest
Carbonate formations, bird-watching and camping. Mountain bike trails. Route 368 km. 2.4 Open Tue-Sun 9am-5pm Tel. 787-502-6754

- MARICAO**
- Maricao Forest
Observation tower, stone house, hiking and bird watching. Route 120 south. Open Mon-Fri 7:00am-3:00pm, Sat-Sun 8:00am-4:00pm. Tel. 787-838-1040

- SOUTH ROUTE - PORTA CARIBE**
- GUAYAMA**
- Aguirre Forest
Located between the municipalities of Santa Isabel and Guayama. Mangroves area, tidal flats, 87 species of birds rookeries, research lakes and large manatee population. Route 7710 of south #3. Open Tue-Sun 9am-5pm Tel. 787-864-0105
 - Mariposario Las Limas Natural Reserve
Natural forest with walking trails. Different species of butterflies, flowers, birds, beautiful gardens, educative museum and river. Route 747, Km 0.7, Culebra Sector. Open Thu-Sun 10am-1pm, call for reservation. Tel. 787-864-6037
- PONCE**
- Julio Enrique Monagas Park
Family-oriented park with paddle boats, skate parks, picnic areas and gazebos. Route 2, Ponce Bypass. Open Tue-Sun, 9:00am-5:00pm. Tel. 787-284-2124
- PATILLAS**
- Charco Azul
A small river forms a natural pool called Charco Azul. Route 183 and 184, Jagual and Marin neighborhoods. Open Tue-Sun 9am-5pm. Tel. 787-747-510

- EAST ROUTE**
- CULEBRA ISLAND**
- National Wildlife Refuge
Covers 1,580 acres, over 50,000 marine birds of 13 species, 23 adjacent island and rock formations, all maintained in their natural state.
- VIEQUES ISLAND**
- Mosquito Bioluminescent Bay
A moonless night spectacle! The microscopic organisms that shine disturbed are protozoan of the dinoflagellate family. The luminescence is a defense reaction. Access through Sun Bay. Route 997 km.7 Tel. 787-741-8683
- HUMACAO**
- Humacao Wildlife Reserve
Over 90 birds species, surrounded by lagoons, marine turtle nesting grounds, and recreational fishing. A great place to go kayaking. Route 3 km.74.3 Open Mon-Fri 8am-4pm. Tel. 787-852-6088

- VILLALBA**
- Mirador Villalba-Orocovis
Located over 2,000 feet above sea level. Fantastic view of south and north coast; Atlantic Ocean and Caribe Sea. Route 143 Km 39.8. Open Wed-Sun 9am-5pm. Tel. 787-867-6111/787-546-5065

- BARRANQUITAS**
- San Cristóbal Canyon
This beautiful canyon is an Indiana Jones experience! Between Aibonito and Barranquitas. Route 725, Km 5.1. Tel. 787-857-2094 / 787-647-3402

- CAYEY**
- Carite Forest Wildlife Refuge
It lodges 49 species of birds, 15 species of amphibians, 12 species of reptiles and 7 species of mammals. Route 184 km. 27.5 Open Tue-Sun 9am-5pm. Tel. 787-747-4510

- CEIBA**
- Ceiba Forest
95% of the forest is classified as 4 species as mangrove with birds, turtles, and manatees. End of Route 195, Santa Rita Sector Open Tue-Sun 9am-5pm

- FAJARDO**
- Cabezas de San Juan Natural Reserve
A 316-acre peninsula, showcasing many different ecosystems. Featuring a bioluminescent bay, a neoclassical lighthouse and a nature center. Route 987, Km 6. Open Wed-Sun 9:30am-2:00pm. Tel. 787-722-5882
 - Laguna Grande Bioluminescent Lagoon
Take eco-adventure tours in kayaks to the bioluminescent bay and lagoons, with licensed guides and equipment included. Located in Route 987.

- LUQUILLO**
- Hacienda Carabali
Horseback rides on Paso Fino and well-trained horses carefully matched to each rider's ability. Located in Route 992, Km 3.0. Tel. 787-889-2851
